Can we remind parents and carers that Governors

### DO NOT

authorise any leave of absence for holidays during term time. Prolonged absence can have a detrimental effect on a child's learning and progress and Governors want to encourage parents not to take their child out of school for family holidays.

Any child absent from school for more than 20 days could lose their school place. If a child is absent for more than 6 days, a warning letter is sent out from the local authority which can lead to a fine being issued to parent of £60.00 per child per parent.
